- Formulate & Test Hypotheses
- Collaborate with Project Team & Integrate Workstreams
- Develop & Present Recommendations

"Our day-to-day work is likely to have both a problem-solving and analytical component (e.g., market research, data analysis, prioritization exercises), and a relational component (working closely with clients to find answers that will work in their context) - essentially, expect to do tons of research, give presentations, organize proposals, meet with clients and crunch a lot of numbers." 


# Pre-MBA Experience for Students Interning in Consulting: Class of 2018






# Source of Consulting Internship Offers: Class of 2018\*



# Two Strategies = Two Skillsets Management Consulting Recruiting Strategy

### **MATURE**

- Follow structured process and timeline
- Be ready for when an opportunity is available
- Prepare for and attend "formal" recruiting events
- Market your candidacy and differentiators
- Conduct on-campus interviews
- Manage heavy recruiting schedule in fall/winter



### **ENTERPRISE**

- Navigate unstructured process and timeline
- Be ready if an opportunity becomes available
- Prepare for multi-format networking opportunities
- Proactively build & leverage network, pitch solutions and employment opportunities
- Travel to companies and recruiters
- Sustain recruiting efforts throughout the year

# Recruiting as International Students / Global Job Seekers

### **US OFFICES**



- Most of the 9 management consulting firms recruiting at Wharton sponsor non-US work authorized students to work in the U.S.
- Strong English language skills and knowledge of U.S. business customs/industry trends
- Experience living or working in the U.S.

### **INT'L OFFICES**



- Many international offices recruit at Wharton
- Process may feel more "Enterprise" - fewer inperson interactions and more phone-based networking
- Regional work experience and language skills are usually required
- Visa rules can sometimes prevent hiring of non-work authorized students

## **Advice for Career Switchers**

### Firms are looking for you to:

- Highlight your relevant and transferable skills
- Translate your previous experience into how you can add value to their firm and clients
- Demonstrate your intellectual curiosity, your love of solving problems and your ability to make an impact
- Show your ability to quickly and confidently master new business topics
- Excel in case interviews; show your interest in discussing business issues and prove your ability to adapt to new situations


